



# CAJUN STUD GAMING GUIDE

## HOW TO PLAY

**The object of the game is to get a five card poker hand consisting of 6's or better.**

You make an initial Ante bet to receive two hole cards. Upon reviewing your two hole cards, you may fold or raise on the first raise betting circle. If you raise, you may raise one to three times your Ante bet. The dealer then reveals the first community card on the board. You may now fold or raise one to three times your Ante on the second raise betting circle. The dealer then reveals the second community card on the board. You may once again fold or raise one to three times your Ante on the last raise betting circle. The dealer then reveals the third and final community card on the board, and pushes (ties) everyone who has a pair of 6's-10's, and pays everyone who has a pair of jacks or better.

## WAGERS

**Ante** - Make this wager to receive cards to play against the posted pay table. Pushes on 6's-10's, and wins with jacks or better.

**Raise** - You may raise one to three times your ante bet to win with jacks or better or push with 6's-10's.

Outcome	Pay Table
Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	100 to 1
Four of a Kind	40 to 1
Full House	11 to 1
Flush	7 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Three of a Kind	3 to 1
Two Pair	3 to 2
Pair of Jacks or Better	1 to 1
Pair of Sixes - Tens	Push
Other	Loss

**Board Bonus** - Make this bet to win if the three community cards consist of one pair or better. See posted pay tables for payouts.

Outcome	Pay Table
Mini Royal	50 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1
Three of a Kind	30 to 1
Straight	6 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Pair	1 to 1
Other	Loss

**Lo Ball** - Have a bad hand? Make this wager and get paid odds if your hand is 7-high through jack-high.

Outcome	Pay Table
7 High	100 to 1
8 High	50 to 1
9 High	15 to 1
10 High	5 to 1
Jack High	1 to 1
Queen High	Loss
Other	Loss

**Pocket Bonus** - Compare your two pocket cards with the posted pay table for a generous reward.

Outcome	Pay Table
Pocket Rockets (Pair of Aces)	25 to 1
Ace Plus a Face - Suited	20 to 1
Ace Plus a Face - Non Suited	10 to 1
Pair	5 to 1
Other	Loss

\$50,000 max payout per player per hand applies to the Ante and Raise wager only.
