

Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Monday 06/17/19

Race One:

1st: **(6) TAKEANOTHERCHANCE** – Did nothing in her first two starts on the dirt at Tampa Bay Downs but woke up when shipped here and was a good second at long odds. She came back to win going away and now meets modest winners for the red-hot John Bourke.
2nd: **(1) MISS CINDY LOU WHO** – Made her Tapeta debut here two starts back and went gate to wire. She came back and tired last out when facing better winners and now drops down in class for Kevin Rice who wins 16% third start off the layoff.
3rd: **(2) KAPRANCY** – Was beaten almost 70 lengths four starts in a row but made her Tapeta debut with a good effort last out.

Race Two:

1st: **(2) PIZZA MAN PETE** – Began the year with an even third two starts back against open company then came back to run well against this state-bred allowance level. Glenn Wismer wins 34% going short to long and draws well with Addiel Ayala.
2nd: **(1) LEAVEITLONELARRY** – Horse for the course returned off a long layoff with a good third after being shuffled back from post one going six furlongs and now draws post one again but he's going a mile. Scott Spieth rides back – 28% with his route mounts.
3rd: **(3) WHATDOISTANDFOR** – Returned off a long layoff with a good 3rd when Lasix was added for the first time then ran evenly last out.

Race Three:

1st: **(8) OUR GIRL SNICK** – Was overmatched in her first five starts but dropped down to this maiden claiming level and rallied for second in her first start in nine months. Dave Markgraf wins 21% with his maiden claimers and 19% second start off the layoff.
2nd: **(10) TIMBERLINE LODGE** – Did nothing in her first three career starts but returned off a long layoff here with a good third when making her Tapeta debut. She came back and showed good speed next out and meets the same group.
3rd: **(2) KUKOO KUNUKU** – Had a good race here last year and improved some last out when dropped down to this class level.

Race Four:

1st: **(2) MANDERS** – Was a good third in her career debut going 5 ½ furlongs then came back and was up the track. Off for eight months, she made her Tapeta debut with a good third going six furlongs in very fast time for John Bourke who wins 19% second start off the layoff.
2nd: **(6) GRANITE CANDY** – First-time starter by Twirling Candy (18% debut winners) is out of a dam by D'Wildcat (12% debut winners). Glenn Wismer is 3 for 9 with his debut runners and 19% with his overall maiden special weight starters. Antonio Gallardo rides.
3rd: **(4) TOBAGO** – Daughter of Pioneer of the Nile makes her Tapeta debut for Graham Motion. She's a half to four stakes winners.

Race Five:

1st: **(6) GREATEST GAME** – Horse for the course won here three starts back then finished up last year with a good third. He came back here with a rallying third going six furlongs in fast time and now stretches out to two turns for Tim Girten who wins 19% in this spot.
2nd: **(3) IM CHILLIN** – Raced on turf at Tampa Bay Downs with good results then shipped back up here and won going a mile. He came back and won again. Horse for the course moves up in class for Ron Potts who wins 17% first start after a win.
3rd: **(4) COLTRANE** – Speedball could be hard to catch if Antonio Gallardo can run away and hide from these.

Race Six:

1st: **(1) WELLABLED** – Speedball Chicago shipper won a similar stakes race here last year and continues to run great. He returned off a long layoff last out at Arlington Park and won a allowance race by nine lengths. He has worked well since then and draws the rail.
2nd: **(5) LANIER** – Ran well on the synthetic track at Turfway Park then went to Chicago and won a grade three stakes race there going a one-turn mile. Brett Santangelo wins 14% first start after a win and 38% second start off the layoff.
3rd: **(4) CALORIC** – Won here going six furlongs in blazing-fast time here and could get the right setup behind the speed today.

Race Seven:

1st: **(2) OUR PROMISE** – Raced on the dirt over the winter at Tampa Bay but shipped here and won going away in fast time against first-level allowance foes. Tim Hamm wins 19% first start after a win and is 3 for 4 when he rides Scott Spietch.
2nd: **(1) ENJAY'S BRASS** – Was outrun against grade three stakes company then romped by four lengths going short. She did nothing in her last start and returns off a 170-day layoff for Mike Trombetta who wins 20% with this surface switch. Antonio Gallardo gets the ride.
3rd: **(6) CAPE TRIOS** – Has run well in all four starts here and could improve in her second start off the long layoff.

Race Eight:

1st: **(10) HONOR LIFE** – Was claimed for \$16K two starts back at the end of last season then returned here three weeks ago dropping down to this claiming level with a good third. Jeff Radosevich win 24% second start out of his barn and 23% second start off the layoff.
2nd: **(2) MAD JACK** – Added blinkers last out and he rallied for second to lose by a head in her second start off the long layoff. He has a big late kick and gets Pablo Morales back aboard. Joe Martin wins 15% third start off the layoff.
3rd: **(6) BEST BUD** – Added blinkers last out and almost held on against better on the dirt at Penn National.
