Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Wednesday 07/03/19

Race One:

1st: (3) STEVIS MAN – Horse for the course goes for win number 15 here at the age of nine. He came back and beat this class level twice in a row going this distance. Darien Rodriguez wins 31% third start off the layoff and 26% first start after a win. 2nd: (1) DON'T BE SO SALTY – Tapeta specialist has won six times here and four times at Woodbine. He comes in here off three straight wins in Canada in very fast times. Shane Meyers wins 23% with his synthetic-track starters and gets Scott Spieth.

Race Two:

1st: (5) LIL HOOH'S HOOH – Raced evenly two starts back going six furlongs then stretched out to two turns last out and held on by a neck after disputing the pace every step. Mark Hoffman wins 19% with his overall claimers and she gets Addiel Ayala back aboard.
2nd: (6) FELL FROM GRACE – Horse for the course has won ten times already. She showed high speed two starts back against \$8,000 claimers then lost all chance when dropped down to this level when she broke poorly. Huber Villa-Gomez rides back.
3rd: (1) JEWELISA – Raced over the weekend on the synthetic track at Turfway Park then after a poor turf start, she ran third here.

Race Three:

1st: (5) DALLIANCE – Dropped down to this claiming level two starts back and was an even third going six furlongs then race evenly again going 5 ½ furlongs. He stretches out to two turns for Wayne Rice who wins 10% in this spot and his last 21 show a flat-bet profit.
 2nd: (4) NEVERLOOKBACK – Broke his maiden last out going 5 ½ furlongs when he swept to the lead in the stretch and the son of Hard Spun is bred to get two turns. Ed Rojas wins 29% first start after a maiden win and 19% going short to long.
 3rd: (6) YAMBURF – Raced evenly in a wide trip against this claiming level two starts back then improved some when dropped in class.

Race Four:

1st: (4) DIMATE – Still a maiden after 13 tries but he added blinkers two starts back on the turf at Arlington Park last July. He came back here against this maiden claiming level and was a good second going two turns as the beaten odds-on favorite.
 2nd: (3) DARBY DART – Added blinkers two starts back and did little going 5 ½ furlongs then stretched out to this distance and ran fourth in a wide trip from post nine. He drops down in class for Ryan Walsh who wins 17% with his maiden claimers and picks up Gallardo.
 3rd: (5) ELECTRIC DRILL – Winless in ten tries but nine of them came against better company.

Race Five:

1st: (5) FORGOTTEN PEACE – First-time starter from Tim Girten who wins 30% with his debut runners and 37% with his maiden special weight starters. Daughter of Jersey Town (12% debut winners) is out of a dam by Sunday Silence (19% debut winners).
2nd: (4) GRANITE CANDY – Showed high speed in her well-bet career debut for Glenn Wismer who wins 18% with his maiden special weight starters. She is a daughter of Twirling Candy – sire of Saturday's Queen's Plate on the Tapeta at Woodbine.
3rd: (1) SUNDAY EXPRESS – Returns off a 180-day layoff who tries Tapeta for the first time.

Race Six:

1st: (3) RUNNIN FOR DACE – Horse for the course has two wins and three seconds in five starts here. He was a good second two starts back then romped last out. He comes back for the same claiming price for Ron Potts who wins 21% third start off the layoff.
 2nd: (8) BEST BUD – Ran well against better on the dirt at Penn National then tried Tapeta last out and his late rally fell a head short. He has low-percentage connections but the same as his last start so it should only insure a decent price.
 3rd: (2) RED ANGRY BIRD – Only 1 for 16 lifetime here but this is the lowest price he has ever run for. Pablo Morales back aboard.

Race Seven:

1st: (2) DANCE OR STROLL – Horse for the course is 6 for 12 lifetime and won two starts back going this distance. She weakened some last out going six furlongs as the 3/5 favorite for leading trainer Gerry Brooks who wins 23% with his synthetic-track starters. 2nd: (3) QUEENOFTHEKINGDOM – Horse for the course has four wins including two good wins coming from off the pace. Gerry Brooks wins 19% first start after a win and when he uses Erin Walker – big, flat-bet profit with her 67 sprint rides this year. 3rd: (5) NAUT A GIVER – Showed good speed here in her seasonal debut against better and now drops down to the bottom.

Race Eight:

1st: (4) ROMAN APPROVAL – Raced evenly here in his Tapeta debut going two turns against \$8,000 claimers then came back against the same group and ran the same race. Teresa Connelly drops him to the bottom and gets Antonio Gallardo to ride back.

2nd: (1) **TREE FIRE** – Returned to the races off an eight-month layoff and rallied wide from post eight to just miss. He comes back against the same claiming level for Eddie Clouston who wins 23% second start off the layoff and picks up Willie Martinez.

3rd: (7) ECHOES OF THUNDER - Horse for the course has had three starts here and should be ready for a big effort today.
