

## Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Tuesday 07/16/19

### Race One:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(5) THIRTY NINE SEVEN** – Has yet to win here in five tries this year but she rallied for second last out when dropped down to this level. She has a good late kick and draws well for a clear trip. Lisa Allen wins 6% with her overall claimers but is 0 for 28 using Mike Allen.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(1) DAILY FEATURE** – Horse for the course beat cheaper on a muddy track at Mountaineer Park then came back there and won again. Eddie Clouston wins 27% first start after a win and 20% with his overall claimers.

### Race Two:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(2) I ADMIRE YOU** – Did absolutely nothing in her first 5 career starts then dropped down to bottom-level claimers at Finger Lakes and was a good second. She came here last out and just missed against this maiden claiming level and gets Antonio Gallardo back aboard.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(6) PHIL'S BABE** – Woke up here in her Tapeta debut going two turns and was a good second when dropped to this level. She came back and showed good speed before tiring as the 7/5 favorite and now turns back to six furlongs for Lance Stokes.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(3) LINDA BUG** – Raced without impact in her well-bet career debut and now comes back with first-time Lasix and blinkers.

### Race Three:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(6) HIMMAH** – Former Irish filly raced well there on the turf then shipped to California last year with mixed results. She did nothing in a wide trip when making her Tapeta debut but that was the end of the season and shows up here for Teresa Connelly while dropping down.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(4) IRREVOCABLE TRUST** – Was outrun in her career debut going six furlongs on the dirt at Oaklawn Park then came back and flashed good speed going two turns at Indiana Downs. Daughter of Stay Thirsty drops in class and distance for Kelly Gorder.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(1) SUNDAY EXPRESS** – Seems to run well every other start so she could be due for a better effort here on the class dropdown.

### Race Four:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(1) TEMPLE CITY STAR** – Had one good race on the turf at the Fair Grounds this winter but did nothing on a sloppy track in his dirt debut two starts later. Last out, he made his Tapeta debut and he missed by a head going two turns and now drops down in class.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(6) ROCK IT TOTHEMOON** – Made his Tapeta debut two starts back with blinkers added and he was a good second going 5 ½ furlongs as the odds-on favorite. He came back to just miss last time out and now stretches out to two turns for Mike Trombetta.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(2) OFFING** – After six poor efforts, he woke up some two starts back against cheaper at long odds then just missed last out at 7/5.

### Race Five:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(4) HILLBILLY RACER** – Went gate to wire here two starts back here last year then returned exactly 12 months later and weakened against this state-bred allowance foes. He shows a bullet workout for this and could be the one to catch in Huber Villa-Gomez sends him.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(1) SIGNS OF GREATNESS** – Broke his maiden first time out in May then raced evenly with first-time lasix when dropped down to open company \$25K claimers. He came back and just missed last out so he moves back up in class for Dave Markgraf – 17% sprinting.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(6) CHARLIE CHARLIE** – Horse for the course beat cheaper off a long layoff and gets Mario Pino back aboard.

### Race Six:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(6) CHASING THE KITTY** – Romped in her career debut here going a mile and that led to racing against stakes foes. This year, she just missed in her first start off the layoff then she came back and got up in time by a head with a strong, ride rally.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(5) FEETS OF FEATHER** – Consistent filly was a game second in her Tapeta debut then was an even third next time out. She won going away when she rallied into a slow pace and now moves up to allowance foes for Joe Cheeks.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(1) LACEE** – Five-year-old mare has made all 23 starts here and was a good third against this level last out.

### Race Seven:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(3) BRING IT ON HOME** – Horse for the course won her first two starts here, ran second two times in a row, then came back to go gate to wire last out. She meets the same level for Gerry Brooks who wins 19% first start after a win and 22% when he rides Erin Walker.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(4) PASSIONATE EMOTION** – After being claimed at Gulfstream Park, she came here and was an even fourth going six furlongs. Last out, her late rally fell a neck short and now she turns back to five furlongs which she has run well at.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(1) EDDINGTONS NOTE** – Horse for the course has returned to the races with three good races without winning.

### Race Eight:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(4) K'S LITTLE BILL** – Made his Tapeta debut three starts back here against this claiming level and won easily. After tiring next time out, he bounced back with a sharp win going five furlongs for Joe Martin – 11% first start after a win.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(1) CEE 'N O** – Horse for the course won his first two starts here off the long layoff going five furlongs then was a game second last out. Eight-year-old comes back at the same claiming level and until someone claims him, he will keep racing against them.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(2) RED CAT** – Just missed two races back then won by a head after being used hard from post one.
