

Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Tuesday 08/06/19

Race One:

1st: **(4) ANOTHER TRY** – Broke his maiden two starts back here going six furlongs as the odds-on favorite. He came back here at two turns and just missed and now drops back to a sprint for Jonathan Sheppard who wins 7% going long to short.

2nd: **(1) SIGNS OF GREATNESS** – Broke his maiden in his career debut here then raced well the next three starts after Lasix was added. He beat open company claimers last out with a strong rally from post one for Dave Markgraf who wins 21% first start after a win.

Race Two:

1st: **(5) NO WAY NEVER** – Broke his maiden here off a long layoff in his Tapeta debut. He raced evenly the next start against better then dropped down to this conditioned claiming with a good second for Linda Rice who wins 33% first start after being beaten as the favorite.

2nd: **(4) DEEP THINKER** – Raced evenly two starts back here going six furlongs in good time then broke his maiden by five lengths when dropped in class. He comes back against modest winners for Teresa Connelly who wins 21% first start after a win.

3rd: **(3) MIKADO** – Only 1 for 24 lifetime but his recent starts here have been solid and he gets Mike Allen back aboard.

Race Three:

1st: **(4) ROYAL RUTHIE** – Moves up in class but at least she shows high speed which could come in handy against this paceless group. Randy Russell wins 13% with this move up in maiden class and 11% with his overall maiden special weight starters.

2nd: **(3) ALTAR OF SPEED** – Best race was two starts back against high-class maiden claimers at Churchill Downs. He came back there on the turf and did little so now she faces state-bred maidens for Matt Kintz who wins 27% off medium rest and he adds blinkers.

3rd: **(1) JERSEY STORM** – First-time starter for Joe Martin who doesn't have many of them but she shows a fast workout for this.

Race Four:

1st: **(3) DOUBLE RAINBOW** – Beat similar claiming company three starts back then was a close second in his next two starts here. Son of Ghostzapper draws well and gets Antonio Gallardo back aboard – 26% with his route mounts.

2nd: **(7) MAD JACK** – Hasn't won all year this year against this level. He ran well two starts in a row going two turns then rallied strong from post one in a long sprint. Joe Martin wins 12% with his claimers and 13% with his synthetic-track starters.

3rd: **(2) SWINGSTAGE** – Rallied for second two starts back going two turns then was outrun last out when moved up in class.

Race Five:

1st: **(2) CAPT. ZIPPOUNAS** – Beat this claiming level three starts back then missed by a nose in a slow-paced race. He weakened in the deep stretch last out for Gerry Brooks who wins 23% first start after being beaten as the favorite and 25% when he rides Gallardo.

2nd: **(6) GLOBAL HERO** – Made his two-turn debut three starts back here and won going away then just missed when dropped down in class. He was an even third last out for Nick Caruso who wins 16% going long and the last 196 show a flat-bet profit going long.

3rd: **(4) ALANDTOM** – Beat this level here when rallying from way back then was a good 2nd in fast time. Mario Pino picks up the mount.

Race Six:

1st: **(4) DYNAMIC WAR** – Speedball switched to Lance Stokes' barn and promptly won two in a row by wide distance going gate to wire. She came back last out and could not make the lead in a long sprint and goes back to two turns with Gallardo returning.

2nd: **(2) NO INTEREST** – Beat \$25K claimers in her first start off the long layoff then raced one-paced when moved up in class. She dropped down to this \$12,500 claiming level last out and was a good third for Matt Kintz who is showing signs of heating up.

3rd: **(1) RACINGROSEMARY** – Tries Tapeta after two straight wins going gate to wire on the dirt going two turns at Thistledown.

Race Seven:

1st: **(5) AULT** – Raced well on the Tapeta at Woodbine. After racing on the dirt in Iowa, he made his PID debut last out and missed by a head going two turns against this claiming level. Joe Marting wins 18% with Pablo Morales

2nd: **(7) BELTWAY** – Just missed on the dirt at Thistledown then was a good third here going nine furlongs after taking a late lead. He rallied from far back to win going away against second-level allowance foes on the dirt at Thistledown.

3rd: **(2) BOOMIN GOOSE** – Horse for the course has won seven times here and beat this claiming level three starts back.

Race Eight:

1st: **(9) PRADO'S TRUST** – Broke her maiden here two starts back then could not overcome post nine when she broke poorly. She meets the same group from the same group and picks up Huber Villa-Gomez who wins 15% with his route mounts.

2nd: **(6) THEYKEEPONCOMIN** – Broke her maiden here in her two-turn debut. She was a good second at long odds two starts back then missed by a neck last out. Joe Martin wins 11% going long and 12% with his overall claimers.

3rd: **(5) DOMINANT STRANGER** – Raced evenly going two turns then tired badly when turned back to a sprint.
