

## Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Monday 09/02/19

### Race One:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(3) GALICENO** – Woke up two starts back when Lasix was added and he was second behind a next-out winner. He came back here at class and distance with an even third and tries them again with Mario Pino back aboard – 20% with his sprint rides.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(5) TIZ WAY TO GOLD** – First-time starter from Randy Russell who wins 8% with his debut runners and 9% when they debut against maiden claimers. Son of Tizway (10% debut winners) is out of a dam that has produced four winners from four other foals to race.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(1) TRIAD'S ECHO** – Did little in his first two career starts but was a good second last out going five furlongs.

### Race Two:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(1) GOOD ON YA** – Ran well in his first two career starts while taking money then broke his maiden here easily going six furlongs. He stretches out to two turns for Tim Girten who wins 14% with this distance switch and 23% going long off two sprints.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(3) PIZZA MAN PETE** – Has been stuck at this state-bred allowance level all year but has three seconds and two thirds. Since adding blinkers, he ran well in his last two starts for Glenn Wismer who wins 31% going short to long.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(2) ANOTHER TRY** – Was a good second against this allowance level in his two-turn debut then he was a fast second going short.

### Race Three:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(6) BABY DRAGON** – Held well to be second in her second career start then she raced evenly when dropped down some in class. Teresa Connelly wins 25% with this maiden move and 22% with her synthetic-track starters.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(3) BIONDETTA** – First-time starter from Jeff Radosevich who wins 21% with his debut runners and 29% with his maiden special weight starters. By Biondetti (14% debut winners), she is out of a dam by With Distinction (11% debut winners).  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(5) CHILLY SKY** – First-time starter from leading training Gerry Brooks who is by Sky Mesa (13% debut winners).

### Race Four:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(5) DEEP THINKER** – Broke his maiden here by five lengths three starts back then weakened some in his next two starts. He held well for second when dropped to this conditioned claiming level for Teresa Connelly who wins 24% first start after being beaten as the favorite.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(9) LATE ACT JONES** – Has run evenly three races in a row then weakened here last out going 5 ½ furlongs. He comes back against the same group for Joe Martin who wins 14% with his sprinters and 13% with his claimers.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(11) SUNNY SIDE OVER** – Broke his maiden second time out but raced evenly last out when Lasix was added.

### Race Five:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(7) CLASSICAL LADY** – Horse for the course beat better two of his last three starts and now drops down a notch in class for Ron Potts who wins 18% first start after a win and 36% when he rides Huber Villa-Gomez.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(6) JOYABLE** – Does her best racing when she shows good speed away from the gate. On turf the last five starts, she makes her Tapeta debut for Jeff Radosevich who wins 28% first start out of his barn and 22% with his overall claimers.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(4) RICKEY'S GIRL** – Had been in against better before dropping down with a good third against one level better.

### Race Six:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(8) REEDER** – Has two wins and a close second in her last three starts against this claiming level. She chased the pace from post one last out for Darien Rodriguez who wins 29% with his overall claiming starters and 24% with his sprinters.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(4) BLICHTON** – Horse for the course has won 10 times here including a sharp win last out going six furlongs in fast time. He comes back against the same group for John Bourke who has been red-hot when he rides Walber Alencar.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(5) DR. KOY** – Dropped down to this claiming level two starts back and was a close second each time after taking an early lead.

### Race Seven:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(5) MARGIE IS LIVID** – Made her Tapeta debut a winning one three starts back when she jogged on the lead. She came back to win against then just missed against this allowance level last out for Ron Potts who wins 20% with his synthetic-track starters.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(2) MA DE TAW** – Was a good second two starts back against high-class optional claimers then beat state-breds last out. She draws inside today with Addiel Ayala who wins 14% with his sprint rides and she should be up pressing the pace.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(7) BEYONDELLE** – Won her Tapeta debut then came back and did it against next out against cheaper.

### Race Eight:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(7) ELYSIUM** – Is only 1 for 14 here but she has six seconds; many at this claiming level. Daughter of Congrats ran poorly two starts back as the lukewarm favorite then came back with a much better effort last out. Gerry Brooks wins 17% with his sprint starters.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(11) WENT WITH THE WIND** – Was claimed for \$20K three starts back and raced evenly when moved up in class. She was a good second last out and now takes another drop for Tim Girten who wins 22% in this spot and 21% with his synthetic-track starters.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(6) OUR GIRL SNICK** – Beat this claiming level three starts back then did nothing. She woke up last out with a good third.
