

Roulette is the French word for little wheel. There are 38 numbers printed on the rim of the wheel. Eighteen numbers are in red pockets, eighteen numbers are in black pockets, and two are in green pockets (0 & 00). Players bet on what number the marble will come to a rest in. The marble is spun around the outside of the track and will land in one of the numbers of the spinning roulette wheel.

Players will bet by placing their chips directly on the table. Bets can be made and changed up until the dealer announces "no more bets." There are basically two types of bets across the table layout: inside and outside.

An "INSIDE BET" is a bet within the field of 38 numbers corresponding with the numbers on the wheel (0, 00 & 1-36). An inside bet can be made on one number or up to six numbers. Single number bets yield the highest payoffs (35 to 1).

An "OUTSIDE BET" is placed outside the field. Players can bet the winning number will be even, odd, black, red, in the first, second or third twelve, 1 to 18, 19 to 36, or any combination of these.

Chips can be purchased in any quantity. Before leaving the table, players must cash in their chips for value chips as the Roulette chips are only valid at the Roulette table they are purchased on. Roulette chips come in different colors. Each color represents a different player. The dealer knows exactly which color chips each player is using in order to ensure proper wagers and payouts.

Payouts are made directly on the table in front of the players with the exception of outside bets. Outside bets will be paid next to the original winning wager. Players must be sure and remove all winning wagers that they do not want to bet again. If winning wagers remain on the table when the dealer announces "no more bets," the wager will stand and be subject to the result of the spin.

Roulette is simple. If the number, column, section or color the player has bet on comes in, they win. If it doesn't, the player loses. Should the O or OO come in, the player loses, unless the player has an inside wager on one or both of those numbers.
