

## Presque Isle Downs Selections and Analysis by Dick Powell Wednesday 09/16/20

### Race One:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(5) HOLLEE PEACH** – showed good speed in two turf starts at Indiana Downs then went to Arlington Park and almost went gate to wire on the synthetic. Daughter of Archarcharch stays against the same class level for her Tapeta debut.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(7) LADY MADISON** – ran well on synthetic tracks in Europe the past two years. She did nothing in her American debut at Turfway Park but bounced back last out at Arlington on the turf when she just missed going gate to wire. Andy McKeever wins 21% turf to synthetic.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(1) RED LINGERIE** – broke her maiden in her Tapeta debut here going short then came back two starts later and went gate to wire.

### Race Two:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(8) QUICK ENTRY** – makes his Tapeta debut off a series of dirt sprints out of town. He won at Aqueduct two starts back in January then came back seven months later off the claim and ran an even third against allowance foes at Finger Lakes for Linda Rice.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(1A) AMIGO'S AFFAIR** – returned to the races off a long layoff here and did nothing when not risked for the claim. He came back with an improved effort against this claiming level and his entymate has some ability while getting in light with Amanda Schwartz.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(7) IMA WILDCAT** – did nothing in three straight starts at Tampa Bay Downs but bounced back here and showed good speed.

### Race Three:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(4) TEXAS MUSIC** – went gate to wire to hang on as the 8-5 favorite two starts back here then moved up in class and weakened late. Joe Martin wins 17% with his sprinters and is 7 for 15 when he rides Pablo Morales.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(2) OUR PROMISE** – rallied from off the pace to win going away as the 3-10 favorite two starts back then moves up to this claiming level and almost did it again. Tim Hamm wins 15% with his synthetic-track starters and gets Israel Rodriguez back aboard.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(5) LITTLE CHRISTY** – returned off a two-year layoff and showed speed to the deep stretch against better company.

### Race Four:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(8) FRESHMAN CLASS** – was an even fifth in her Tapeta debut against top maiden company then dropped down some in class & didn't do much better as the favorite. She takes another drop in class for Leland Hayes who wins 33% after being beaten as the favorite.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(7) ENTHRONED** – still a maiden after nine tries but was only beaten a length against better company on the synthetic track at Turfway. She came here and rallied for third after being shuffled back from post one against this maiden claiming level.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(4) FROSTY LINZ** – 0 for 20 lifetime but just missed here in her Tapeta debut against this maiden claiming level.

### Race Five:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(1) GREATEST GAME** – horse for the course chased the pace before weakening behind a next-out winner then dropped down to similar company and was run down in the final 50 yards. Kevin Rice wins 17% with his route runners and Mario Pino wins 32% going long.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(5) EPIC** – ships in off four turf starts at four different racetracks. He took money each time and won three out of the four of them. Ricky Hendriks wins 25% first start after a win and 13% going from turf to synthetic. Pablo Morales picks up the mount.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(3) FOX ROX** – horse for the course won going two turns last out here and moves up in class.

### Race Six:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(6) WHISTLE ME HOME** – was only beaten a length against this open allowance level two starts back then held on for second after taking the lead in the deep stretch. Walber Alencar picks up the mount – 4 for 9 riding for John Gucciardo and 21% with his route mounts.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(8) DRIFTWOOD** – broke his maiden here last year. He has spent most of this year on the turf but shipped here last out and won by a length last out going a two-turn mile in very fast time. Ron Potts wins 18% first start after a win and 22% with Huber Villa-Gomez.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(7) HEY BIG GUY** – just missed making up 10 lengths two starts back then won by a neck against cheaper company than this.

### Race Seven:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(3) STORM ADVISORY** – just missed here two starts back when he rallied from just off the pace. He was an even third last out and tries the same group again. Shane Meyers wins 19% with his synthetic-track starters and gets Addiel Ayala.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(2) OLDZFOURFORTYTWO** – looks to have enough gate speed to overcome post one. Horse for the course was a sharp winner last out against this level and returns to be claimed for Manny Criollo who will keep running him against these state-bred optional claimers.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(4) SIGNS OF GREATNESS** – tired against open allowance foes two starts back but just missed against these last time out.

### Race Eight:

1<sup>st</sup>: **(10) FROST PROOF** – opened up a big lead two starts back before being run down late then came back and tried to set a slower pace to no avail. He should get loose again with David Delgado back aboard.  
2<sup>nd</sup>: **(2) COTTON HOUSE** – was a good second on the turf against better two starts back then shipped here and was beaten less than a length when dropped down to this level. Ricky Hendriks wins 18% with his route mounts and he gets Pablo Morales back aboard.  
3<sup>rd</sup>: **(5) THE FILTER** – raced evenly in his PID debut then came back and weakened in a fast race so now he drops down in class.
