Mini Baccarat

GAMING GUIDE

Baccarat has long been among the most popular game in casinos all over the world.

While many associate this elite game with sophistication, Baccarat may be the simplest table game to play! The object of the game is to bet on the hand with a final point total closest to 9.

In Mini Baccarat, there are three ways to make a wager. Each player may bet on the player or the banker and/or a tie.

Points are counted by cards numbered 1 through 9 and are counted at face value. 10s and face cards count as 0. Aces count as 1.

If the cards total a two-digit number, only the last digit counts. Example: 6+7 = 13. 13 counts as 3. The hand with a point total closest to 9 wins. The score will always be a range from 0 to 9.

The round of play will commence with the Dealer dealing four cards. The first and third cards represent the "Player" hand and the second and fourth card represent the "Banker" hand. A third card may or may not be dealt to either the "Player" or the "Dealer" depending on the total of the hands. If either "Player" or "Banker" total 8 or 9, this is a "natural" and no cards are drawn and the highest total wins. The following are the rules of when each side draws:

PLAYER HAND THIRD CARD RULE

(when the first two cards total)

0-1-2-3-4-5	Draws A Card
6-7	Stands
g_g	Natural Stands

BANKER HAND THIRD CARD RULE

When the Player stands on 6 or 7, the Banker will always draw on totals of 0-1-2-3-4 and 5, and stand on 6-7-8-9.

When the player does not have a natural, the banker shall draw on the totals of 0-1 or 2, and then observe the following rules:

When the first two cards total:

	DRAWS WHEN PLAYER'S THIRD CARD IS:	STANDS WHEN PLAYER'S THIRD CARD IS:
3	1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-0	8
4	2-3-4-5-6-7	1-8-9-0

Winning Player and Banker bets are paid even money. Winning Banker bets are charged 5% commission collected at the time they are paid. Winning tie bets are paid 8 to 1.

DRAGON BONUS

The Dragon Bonus is a Baccarat side bet that pays when your hand is a natural winner or wins by a large margin. The highest payout is for a non-natural that wins by nine points (see paytable for odds).

GETTING STARTED

Make the Dragon Bonus wager by getting the marked area. You may bet the Dragon Bonus wager for the Player, the Banker, or you may bet them both. Presque Isle Downs does require you to make a standard Baccarat wager.

WINNING AND LOSING

You have two ways to win:

- 1. When your hand is a natural winner
- 2. When your non-natural hand wins by at least four points
