\*The 56-day Rule IS still in effect
\*If you are shipping in, contact our stall superintendent Andrea Moreno 323-6864

\*NO Standing in ice for "IN TODAY HORSES" until regulatory Vet has done the pre-race exam. You can get your "Horse In Today" sign from the stall

superintendent
\*Once a horse is admitted onto the racetrack grounds to participate in a race, no
horse shall be removed from the racetrack at anytime without specific medical or veterinary authorization and without approval from the Stewards and Racetrack Management (181.75)

\*TRAINERS: It is YOUR responsibility to declare any permitted medication or approved change of equipment at the time of entry- INCLUDING SHOES.

### HISA/HIWU RULES TO KNOW:

The racing office will not, under any circumstances, allow an entry for any horse, owner, responsible person, or jockey who is not registered with HISA. Please be sure all parties on the entry are HISA compliant. We will also not accept entries for horses on any vet or stewards list in PA or another jurisdiction. It is the trainer's responsibility to know whether the horse running for them has any eligibility issues.

\*The use of ANY handheld or Audio device is PROHIBITED while the Rider is on a Covered Horse or Pony Horse (HISA Rule 2275)

\*A horse that is scratched due to sickness, illness or injury will now require an attending veterinarian exam recorded in the HISA portal PRIOR to being eligible to re-enter in a race. Previously these horses had an automatic off date. After July 2024, a horse scratched as pick as illness contacts the removed from the Vetice. 8, 2024, a horse scratched as sick or illness cannot be removed from the Vet's List until an exam has been submitted by the attending veterinarian. Once this has been completed, trainers will need to contact the PSHRC Test Barn to have the horse removed from Vet's List.

\*HIWU's testing program includes the testing of selected horses after routine timed workouts/breezes. This testing is separate from Vets List testing. Trainers will be notified of selection for post-work testing within one hour of a horse's completion of the breeze. For more information about medications that can be used in relation to a routine breeze, visit the "News" tab on hiwu.org for the latest advisory.
