Lost and Found Takes The Satin and Lace Stakes

The conditions could not have been better for a race night at Presque Isle Downs. With temperatures in the 70's and a light breeze under sunny skies with a few puffy clouds, six fillies and mares took to the fast Tapeta surface in search of capturing the 19th edition of the \$100,000 guaranteed Satin and Lace Stakes at six furlongs. The race is considered a steppingstone to the track's signature event, the \$300,000 guaranteed Grade II Masters Stakes in September for distaff sprinters going six-and-a-half furlongs.

The morning line favorite was Lost and Found. She hails from the Brittany T. Russell outfit and has two starts under her belt prior to the Satin and Lace. First was a third-place finish in The Very One Stakes on Black Eyed Susan day during Preakness weekend at Laurel Park in Maryland in May. Her next try came at Presque Isle Downs, where she led pillar to post in a six-furlong allowance race in mid-June, winning by a very convincing five and ½ lengths.

Hen race time rolled around, the Satin and Lace field was narrowed from nine to six with the defections of Wisconsin Gal, Les Reys (FR), and La Artista.

Lost and Found (jockey Israel Rodriguez) went to the early lead with Mitole Magiec (Gaddiel Martinez) taking early chase with Graham Motion-trainee Ribaltagaia (Romero Maragh) in third. After an opening quarter of 21 3/5 seconds, Lost and Found was able to nurse her advantage through the turn and into the top of the stretch past the half mile ark in 44 3/5 seconds.

"It was the same plan we had as the last time we raced her," said jockey Israel Rodriguez.

He added, "she's a perfect three for three racing over the synthetic, and we knew she liked the surface here."

Lost and Found showed no signs of giving up the lead, with the exception of Cynane (Sahin Civaci), none of the rivals showed signs of passing another, although the field did tighten up a bit in the stretch.

As the field was nearing the wire, Lost and Found still had enough left in her tank to win by a head, while Mitole Magic held off Ribaltagaia by a neck. Further back, Cynane was a neck ahead of Dala (Walter Rodriguez), while Stylet (Scott Spieth) rounded out the six. The running time was one minute, nine and 3/5 seconds.

Lost and Found is a four-year-old daughter of Liam's Map out of the Tapit mare Taparri. She was bred in Kentucky by Woodford Thoroughbreds, LLC and is owned by Golden Lion Racing.

As for her next start, it would not be surprising if her connections decided to come back to Erie to try to capture the Masters next month if all is well with Lost and Found.



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
